Key Course Content:

- Recognising and accepting mistakes as a natural part of the learning process
- Understanding the impact of our mistakes on ourselves and others
- Reflecting on the root causes of our mistakes and identifying ways to prevent them in the future
- Developing resilience and the ability to bounce back from setbacks
- Learning to communicate effectively about our mistakes and being open to constructive criticism
- Cultivating a growth mindset and seeing mistakes as opportunities for learning and development
- Building self-awareness and identifying patterns or tendencies that may contribute to making mistakes
- Practicing self-forgiveness and not dwelling on past mistakes,
- Understanding how to apologise



Target Audience:

Duration:
